Our Philosophy: Your Data is Yours

ImageLab AI was built on a simple premise: Powerful AI should not require sacrificing privacy.

Unlike most AI generators that process your data on remote servers, ImageLab AI runs 100% locally on your device. We do not collect, store, share, or sell your personal information, prompts, or generated images.

1. No Data Collection

We do not collect any user data.

No Accounts: You do not need to create an account or login to use the app.

No Analytics: We do not track your usage, buttons clicked, or time spent in the app.

No Telemetry: We do not send crash reports or performance data to our servers.

2. How the AI Works (Local Processing)

ImageLab AI utilizes advanced image generation models and proprietary "Weight Streaming" technology to generate images directly on your Apple device.

Input: Your text prompts are processed exclusively on your device's hardware.

Output: The images you generate are created locally and saved to your device's memory.

Zero Cloud Processing: Your prompts and images never leave your device. We have no way of seeing what you create.

3. Internet Access

The application requires an internet connection only for the initial setup.

Upon first launch, the app connects to the internet to download the model weights (approx. 3.5GB - 20GB, depending on device).

Once the model is downloaded, the app functions completely offline. You can use ImageLab AI in Airplane Mode.

4. Data Storage & Ownership

Storage: All generated images are stored locally within the app's sandbox or your device's Photo Library (if you choose to save them).

Ownership: You retain full commercial ownership of the images you create. Canvas and The Machine claims no rights over your content.

5. Third-Party Services

Since we do not display ads, use tracking pixels, or employ external analytics engines (like Google Analytics or Mixpanel), there is no third-party data sharing.

6. Apple's Standard Data Collection

Please note that Apple may collect anonymous diagnostic data (crash logs, device type) at the operating system level if you have opted-in to share analytics with App Developers in your iPhone/Mac settings. This is controlled entirely by Apple, and we do not have access to individual user identities through this data.
